

BOARD POLICIES

The following are policies that the Charlotte Board Association has approved.

- Refreshments should remain in the breakroom.
- Directors should not play in their own games unless needed to complete a table.
- No cell phones are allowed to be on in the playing area. If you have an emergency and need to be able to take a call, give the Director your phone.
- North/South seats should be saved for people with disabilities who require it.
- If a player is bleeding, they must leave the table until the bleeding is stemmed appropriately.
- No tobacco products, including e-cigarettes are allowed on the property per County regulations. The penalty for breaking this policy will be a ¼ board on the first infraction. A 2nd infraction will incur a 7 day ban from playing at the Bridge Center.
- Proprietors may not serve on the CBA Board.

- It is the responsibility of the Proprietor to determine if a game will be held, including if there is a call for inclement weather.
- Alcoholic beverages may not be sold or consumed on the premises.
