Co-chairs, Jim Bender and Colleen McMahon are excited about this tournament!! They want you to play and will need your help, too!!!

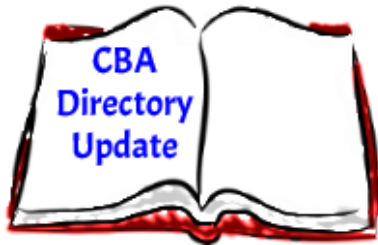
We have a great club and the more "helpers" we have, the easier it will be!! Please say "yes" to Alice Gallagher (volunteer coordinator) when she asks for your help.
