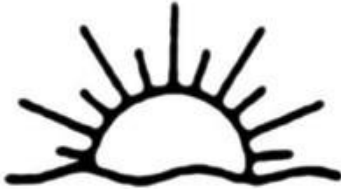

- You can sponsor a game in honor of a person of your choice for a \$100 donation to the Alzheimer's Association. There is a sign-up sheet on the bulletin board.

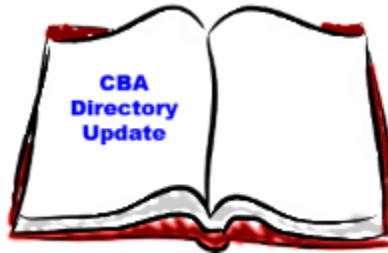
- If you have a business which would like to help sponsor The Longest Day, we would be delighted to give it lots of recognition.

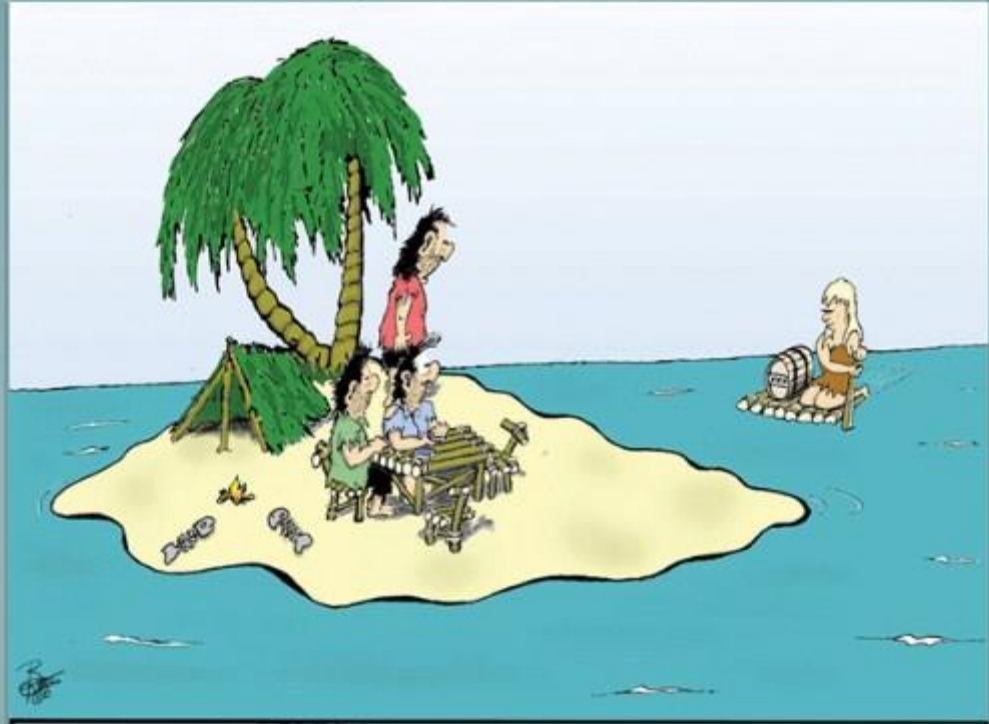
Please replace the dirty cards for the Wednesday's game. Almost all are germ ridden and dirty.
